

## Welcome to the "Yamasong" paper puppet workshop!

**Material List:** (hopefully stuff you can find at home or home office): Printouts (you can print them from this website)

Stapler

Sticks, chopsticks, skewers or popsicle sticks







- 1. Print out 2 character worksheets
- 2. Color the sheets have a blast making them fun colors!
- 3. When finished, cut out the shapes along the dotted lines.
- 4. Make the character puppets stick puppets or tube puppets.
- 5. You can use the other worksheet and glue, tape or staple the other side version so your character can be seen from both directions.









Colored pencils, markers or crayons

Scissors .

Scotch Tape or hot glue

Notecards or Bristol paper

Paper towel or toilet paper tube















## **Bird Puppet Instructions (pg 2):**

- 1. Print the bird worksheet
- 2. Color the bird sheet you can make it metal looking or super colorful!
- 3. Cut out the shapes along the dotted lines.
- 4. Make the head into a tube, fitting the size of your index and middle finger. Staple the front of the nose so that end is closed off.
- 5. Next we make the torso. Stick two fingers out (the head) and the rest closed. Wrap the torso sheet over your hand to see how far it wraps around.
- 6. Use a notecard to complete the body "tube" shape. Staple it on both sides to create a "tube" your hand fits in.



















## **Bird Puppet Instructions (pg 3):**

- 7. Take your sticks, skewers or chopsticks, and cut them down for the bird legs (get an adult to help you).
- 8. Tape or glue the sticks to the bottom of the bird "thighs."
- 9. Now fit your hand inside, add the head on the fingers and you have a finished bird!

**Challenge:** Add more to the puppet to make it more exciting - feathers, glitter, or try adding a character riding on top the bird!
